

Uniform

Seniors can wear Corporate Working Uniform ("Corporate Polo"), Corporate Field Uniform ("Blueberries"), or ABU/Blues in conjunction with cadet activities. It is recommended you bring 2 Tops (corporate and/or ABU). There will be laundry facilities on site. If you plan to do laundry there, you will need to bring laundry soap. Wear comfortable shoes and good socks – you will be walking a lot.

For graduation, please plan to wear either your Corporate Working Uniform, Class B Blues, or Aviator Shirt Uniform. Please do not wear the Corporate Field Uniform or ABU to Graduation.

PT is not required for senior members. During PT, you may wear the PT Uniform you purchased, Corporate Working Uniform, ABU, or plain blue shorts/leggings/workout pants with a plain blue t-shirt. Footwear should be sneakers for those wearing the PT Uniform or the plain blue outfit.

For sleepwear, please pack clothing that you are comfortable for sleeping in with a note that you may be sharing a room. Additionally, the bathroom is down the hall from your room. You may want to include slip-on shoes or slippers that you can wear down to the bathroom, if needed.

You will be provided with a ball cap to wear for the week no matter which uniform you are in. Wearing the ball cap is required. If you would like to pin your rank on your ball cap, please make sure to bring it with you. There is no place to purchase pin-on rank at CEATS.

Toiletries

We've established a Senior Member Restroom on the Second Floor. Most of the cadets are housed on the first floor. You will need to bring portable toiletries (Soap, Shampoo, Conditioner, Deodorant, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Hairbrush, Razor, Hair Ties) that you can take to the bathroom and back to your barracks room with you. There will be no linens provided so make sure to bring towels and washcloths you will need for the week. Please also pack your medications and any OTC medication you think you may need for the week. Sunscreen and bug spray are also required. You may also want to bring shower shoes.

Because there are no linens provided, you will need to bring bedding for yourself including a pillow and pillowcase. Twin XLONG sheets will fit the bed. Though it is summer, it does get cool during the evenings, so you may want to bring a blanket, as well.
